7 good cakes—and easy!—made with Betty Crocker Yellow Cake Mix

You can bake up a rich, moist, homemade kind of yellow cake as easy as opening Betty Crocker Yellow Cake Mix, and adding two fresh eggs and water. Try these easy serving ideas, too!

Chick Cake: First take out Betty Crocker Angel Food Frosting Mix, make "chick" of frosting as candy. Set the hands for the time you'll serve it!

Carrot Snowballs: Make cupcakes, following directions on package. Spread thickly with frosting (use Betty Crocker Angel Food Frosting Mix) and roll in shredded carrots.

Easy Blueberry Muffins: Bake cake in oblong pan. Cut in squares. Split and serve shortcake-style, with plenty of plump blueberries and sweet whipped cream.

Cake Pudding: Grease rim of 1 orange loaf pan. Fill 12 custard cups 3/4 full. The full cup on each; steam 10 min. in 2" of water. Serve hot with orange sauce.

Egg-Daisy Cake: Follow the easy spin-dash cake recipe on package. To make egg daisies, arrange pineapple wedges around marshmallows shortly before you pour in batter.

Raspberry Shortcake: Make a giant short-cake of 2 round layers. Fill and top with slightly sweetened whipped cream and raspberries—or any fruit you're specially fond of.

Strawberry Ice Cream Pie: Bake cake in round layer pan. Spread slightly softened strawberry ice cream on one layer and serve immediately, cut in wedges.
